

SEMINARY VALEDICTORIAN POLICY

This policy is the responsibility of the Registrar and was approved by Seminary Team on February 25, 2022.

POLICY OVERVIEW

This policy details the selection process for the Class Valedictorian of a Seminary graduating class.

PRINCIPLES

This policy is guided by the principles of integrity and transparency.

SCOPE

The policy applies to the Seminary graduating classes of each academic year.

POLICY STATEMENT

- The student selected as the Seminary valedictorian will be chosen from the top five cumulative grade point averages, 3.70 or higher.
- The Seminary Team nominates a valedictorian who best exemplifies...
 - o Their graduating class, normally this would be demonstrated by having been a full-time Briercrest Seminary student (9 credit hours per semester) for at least three semesters, including one of the last three semesters before commencement.
 - o Achievement of the learning outcomes fostered by Briercrest Seminary in all of its graduates (see the first three learning outcomes for all Master's programs).
 - o A heart and aptitude for continued service and leadership in the local church.
- The student must be in good standing in all areas including academics, community life, and ministry.
- The valedictorian is selected from students graduating from the MA or MDiv programs.
